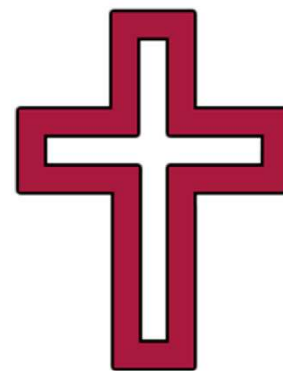

Sunday Morning 10.30am:

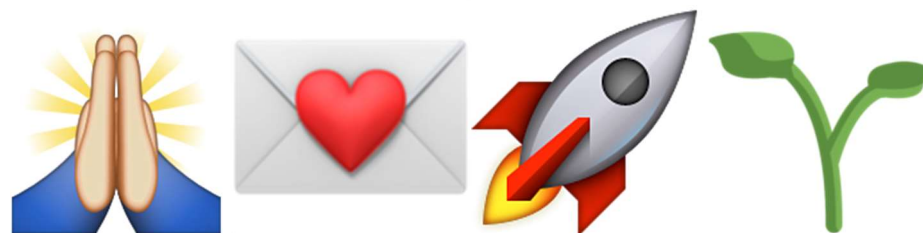
Connect, Cragg, Headingley Morning and Sent Mission Communities all join together to celebrate this Pentecost Sunday.
