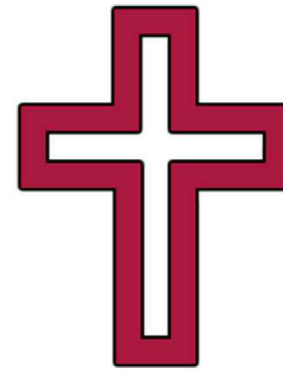
Need more information?
